

## **Cardiff Council Update: 11<sup>th</sup> August**

Here is the latest update from Cardiff Council, covering: the Race Equality Taskforce is seeking applications for membership and views on what its priorities should be; there's still time to have a say on the Tudor Street improvement plans; and you can get in touch with our C2C contact centre team until 8pm via live web chat.

### **Cardiff Race Equality Taskforce**

Racial inequality continues to exist in Cardiff, Wales and the UK. In autumn 2020, we will convene a Race Equality Taskforce to address racial discrimination and promote race equality in the city.

The Taskforce will drive coordinated and strategic action to address inequality in Cardiff, in collaboration with our public sector partners and major employers in the city. It will be responsible for advancing a programme of change and transformation to create a fairer city for our residents from ethnic minority backgrounds.

Over the summer of 2020, we will deliver a public consultation on the priority work streams of the Race Equality Taskforce to understand what our residents think are the biggest issues, and the greatest opportunities, for Cardiffians from ethnic minority backgrounds, so we can focus our thinking and resources into finding the solutions that will have the greatest impact.

### **Call for membership**

We are seeking applications for Taskforce Membership from individuals with insight and interest in race, ethnicity and human rights, who have the ability, experience, opportunity and influence to make changes in their sector, industry and institutions or organisations.

Race Equality Taskforce Members will support the Taskforce Chair, Cllr Saeed Ebrahim, to deliver a programme of work which delivers the following objectives:

- Work with Cardiff's communities and organisations to improve and prioritise race equality to achieve an inclusive, cohesive, thriving and representative city;
- Guide Cardiff's policy and strategy developers to make sure race equality is included in all of their work;
- Use the Council's convening power to advance race equality in the public, private and voluntary sector, working closely, where required, with the Cardiff Public Services Board;
- Coordinate actions and recommendations to advance race equality, focusing on priority work-streams, identified in consultation with the City's BAME residents;

- Report on progress on race equality and the general impact of inequality and discrimination on the BAME communities of Cardiff.

### **Multi-million pound regeneration boost for Tudor Street**

Cardiff's Tudor Street is set to benefit from a multi-million pound regeneration programme designed to create an attractive and vibrant shopping area for the local community and visitors to the Riverside area.

Phase one of the development will see £1m invested in commercial premises which have signed up to take part in the Tudor Street building improvement scheme.

Further funding of approximately £3m has been earmarked for work in early 2021 which will enable a large transformation of the whole street environment.

Consultation on the 2021 work closes the 17<sup>th</sup> August, and the scheme aims to deliver:

- New two-way, segregated cycle lane from Wood Street Bridge to the junction with Clare Street
- A new bus island opposite Plantagenet Street, facilitating bus travel into Central Square and the wider city centre
- New green infrastructure, specifically trees and the planting of rain gardens, promoting opportunities for biodiversity and improved air quality;
- A pleasant and welcoming public environment, enhancing the Gateway into South Riverside from the city centre, with prioritised pedestrian movement through wider pavements and improved pedestrian crossings
- Enhanced access to the Taff trail through realigning the existing ramp and steps at the junction with Tudor Street and
- An improved street environment with new paving, street furniture and lighting

Bydd y Tasglu yn arwain camau gweithredu cydlynol a strategol i fynd i'r afael ag anghydraddoldeb yng Nghaerdydd, ar y cyd â'n partneriaid yn y sector cyhoeddus a chyflogwyr pwysig y ddinas. Bydd yn gyfrifol am hyrwyddo rhaglen o newid a thrawsnewid er mwyn creu dinas decach i'n preswylwyr o gefndiroedd lleiafrifoedd ethnig.

### **Hwb adfywio gwerth miliynau o bunnoedd i Tudor Street**

Bydd Tudor Street yng Nghaerdydd yn elwa ar raglen adfywio gwerth miliynau o bunnoedd sydd â'r nod o greu ardal siopa ddeniadol a bywiog ar gyfer y gymuned leol ac ymwelwyr ag ardal Glan-yr-afon.

Bydd cam un y datblygiad yn gweld £1m yn cael ei fuddsoddi mewn safleoedd masnachol sydd wedi ymrwymo i gymryd rhan yng nghynllun gwella adeiladau Tudor Street.

Mae cyllid pellach o tua £3m wedi'i glustnodi ar gyfer gwaith yn gynnar yn 2021 a fydd yn galluogi trawsnewidiad mawr i amgylchedd y stryd gyfan.

Mae ymgynghoriad ar waith 2021 yn cau ar 17 Awst, a nod y cynllun yw cyflawni:

- Ynys fysis newydd gyferbyn â Plantagenet Street, yn hwyluso teithio ar fysis i'r Sgwâr Canolog a chanol y ddinas yn ehangach
- Seilwaith gwyrdd newydd, yn benodol coed a gerddi glaw, gan hyrwyddo cyfleoedd ar gyfer bioamrywiaeth a gwell ansawdd aer
- Amgylchedd cyhoeddus dymunol a chroesawgar, gwella'r Porth i Dde Glan-yr-afon o ganol y ddinas, gyda blaenoriaeth i gerddwyr drwy balmentydd lletach a gwell croesfannau i gerddwyr
- Gwell mynediad i Daith Taf drwy ailalinio'r ramp a'r grisiau presennol wrth y gyffordd â Tudor Street ac
- Amgylchedd stryd rhagorach, gyda phalmentydd, celfi stryd a goleuadau newydd
