

Cardiff Council Update: 16th July

Here is tonight's update from Cardiff Council, covering: news from today's meeting of the Cardiff Council Cabinet; latest on the opportunity for businesses to use our outdoor event spaces; and poor food hygiene standards results in restaurant fine.

Today's Cardiff Council Cabinet meeting

A meeting of Cardiff Council's Cabinet took place today, the third consecutive meeting to be held over video conference.

Cockroach infestation found at City Road café and takeaway

A married couple have been ordered to pay over £2,000 at Cardiff Magistrates' Court on July 9th after a cockroach infestation was found at their café - Mr Tikka - on City Road last year.

On May 7, 2019, a routine food hygiene inspection was carried out at Mr Tikka, 130 City Road, which operates as a café and takeaway business selling baguettes, baked potatoes and curry dishes.

When the inspector arrived at the café unannounced, the owner, Rubi Begum was seen sweeping two live insects off the counter and white powder, believed to be insecticide, was all over the kitchen floor.

The inspector called the Duty Food Safety Officer immediately as it was clear that there was an active insect infestation at the café and takeaway business.

When the Duty Food Officer arrived later that day, a full inspection was carried out and up to 100 insects were found both dead and alive in total, food was found under the counters and splashed across the walls and dead cockroaches were even found under the tables in the dining area where people were eating.

Gorchymynnwyd i gwpl priod dalu dros £2,000 yn Llys Ynadon Caerdydd ar 9 Gorffennaf ar ôl i bla chwilog duon gael ei ddarganfod yn eu caffi - Mr Tikka – ar Heol y Plwca y llynedd.

Ar 7 Mai 2019, cynhaliwyd archwiliad hylendid bwyd arferol yn Mr Tikka, 130 Heol y Plwca, sy'n gweithredu fel caffi a busnes cludfwyd gan werthu bagéts, tatws pob a phrydau bwyd cyri.

Pan gyrhaeddodd yr arolygydd y caffi'n ddirybudd, gwelwyd y perchennog, Rubi Begum, yn ysgubo dau bryfyn byw oddi ar y cownter ac roedd powdr gwyn, y credir ei fod yn bryfleiddiad, dros lawr y gegin.

Ffoniodd yr arolygydd y Swyddog Diogelwch Bwyd ar Ddyletswydd yn syth gan ei bod yn amlwg bod plâ pryfed yn y caffi a'r busnes cludfwyd.

Pan gyrhaeddodd y Swyddog Bwyd ar Ddyletswydd yn ddiweddarach y diwrnod hwnnw, cynhaliwyd archwiliad llawn a darganfuwyd hyd at 100 o bryfed, yn fyw ac wedi marw; daethpwyd o hyd i fwyd o dan y cownteri ac ar y waliau a darganfuwyd chwilod duon hyd yn oed o dan y byrddau yn yr ardal fwyta lle roedd pobl yn bwyta.
