

COVID-19 Update: 23rd April

In tonight's COVID-19 round-up of the day from Cardiff Council: increasing demand for Cardiff Market home deliveries; the music service plays on; and the launch of MindHub to support the health and wellbeing of children and young people.

Opening hours changing at Cardiff Market as essential food traders focus on home deliveries

Cardiff Market is temporarily reducing its opening hours as essential food traders continue to focus on providing home delivery services during the COVID-19 pandemic.

The Market will now only open to the public on Saturday morning's, from 8am until midday.

Entrance and exit is via the Trinity Street entrance, so that the market team can control the number of customers entering the building and ensure a safe queuing system.

Cabinet Member for Investment and Development, Cllr Russell Goodway said: "Low footfall in the city centre during the ongoing lockdown has had an obvious impact on footfall at the market."

"These temporary changes will allow the traders to maintain their focus on the delivery side of their businesses, free up council staff for other duties, and make sure those who do want to shop at the market, can continue to do so."

Launch of MindHub supports health and wellbeing of children and young people

Cardiff Youth Council in partnership with Cardiff Youth Service and Cardiff and Vale University Health Board have developed a website to support children and young people with emotional and mental health and wellbeing issues in this difficult and challenging time.

The website, called MindHub at www.mindhub.wales, is an on-line portal to services that support children and young people with emotional and mental health and wellbeing issues. Children and young people identified that to get the help they need on-line it takes on average, 16 clicks on pages or links. They wanted to decrease the number clicks people needed to make and so MindHub was developed and the creation of this website has reduced this to 3.

The importance of the need to support children and young people to be part of developments, which ensures meaningful and effective solutions, is central to the work of Cardiff Youth Service. It also plays a key role in the lives of children & young people who live here, and Cardiff's efforts towards becoming a Unicef Child Friendly City.
